

**Sermon Notes – January 21, 2018**  
**You're Not Moses, But That's Okay**  
**(Deuteronomy 34 – Joshua 1:8)**

- I. There is no prophet like Moses. (Deuteronomy 34:10-12)
  - A. He knew God face to face.
  - B. He performed miraculous signs through the power of God.
  - C. He showed all Israel the power and terror of the Lord.
  
- II. There is someone called by God after Moses. (Deuteronomy. 34:9; Joshua 1:1)
  - A. Joshua was the God-called man for the mission.
    1. Mentored by Moses.
    2. Filled with God's wisdom.
    3. Called by God.
  - B. Joshua was the God-prepared man for the mission.
    1. Joshua was willing to be a servant.
    2. Joshua was willing to have a teachable spirit.
    3. Joshua was willing to submit to the authority of Moses.
  
- III. There is a definition of success after Moses. (Joshua 1:2-8)
  - A. Believe the promises of God. (Success)
  - B. Experience the presence of God. (Success)
    1. He will never leave us or forsake us. (Matthew 28)
    2. He is always with us.
  - C. Obey the Word of God. (Success)
    1. Get courage from the Scriptures. (Romans 1:16) (2 Timothy 2:15)
    2. Get confidence from the Scriptures. (Philippians 1:6)(2 Timothy 3:13-17) (Psalm 19, 119)
    3. Get commands from the Scriptures. (Psalm 1) (Matthew 28:19-20)
