

**Sermon Notes – April 22, 2018**  
***It Only Takes One (Joshua 7)***

It only takes one person in an organization, group or church to:

- I. Quench the Spirit. (I Thessalonians 5:19; Isaiah 63:10)
  - A. Displaying an attitude of entitlement. (vs. 21)
    1. Covetousness: I want what I see. (Genesis 3; I John 2:15-16)
    2. Pride: I deserve what I want.
    3. Selfishness: I keep what I get.
  
- II. Live in Open Rebellion.
  - A. Suppresses the Truth. (Romans 1)
  - B. Compromises the Word. (Genesis 3:1)
  - C. Lives in the flesh. (Galatians 5:19-21)
    1. Silver and gold (monetary) (I Timothy 6:9-10)
    2. Babylonian garment. (Shinar - prestige/recognition)(Romans 12:3-5)
  
- III. Invite Judgment.
  - A. The sin of Achan: Stealing from God. (vs. 21)
    1. Sin ALWAYS has consequences. (Romans 6:23a)(Joshua 7:25-26)
  - B. The sin of the people: Pride. (vs. 3)
    1. Sin ALWAYS exposes itself. (Luke 12:1-4)(Proverbs 16:18)
  - C. The sin of Joshua: Faithlessness. (vs. 6-10)
    1. Sin ALWAYS lacks faith. (Hebrews 11:6)
