- I. The Faith of the Daughters Described. 17:4
 - A. The boldness to ask. (*Numbers 27:1-11*)
 - 1. Just like Rahab.
 - 2. Just like Caleb.
 - 3. Just like Achsah.
 - B. The conviction to believe. (*Hebrews 11:1*)
 - 1. An assurance of hope.
 - 2. The conviction of seeing the unseen.
 - C. The confidence to receive. (*Hebrews 11:6*)
 - 1. Based on God's character.
 - 2. Based on God's promises.

- II. The Complaint of the Men Discovered. 17:14-18
 - A. Steeped in arrogance. vs. 14
 - 1. Displaying an entitlement mentality.
 - 2. Displaying a numbers superiority.
 - B. Driven by greed. vs.16
 - 1. Enough is never enough!
 - 2. Satisfaction is never achieved.
 - C. Controlled by cowardice. vs.16-18
 - 1. Scared of the number of Canaanites.
 - a. In spite of the promise of God.
 - 2. Scared of the weapons of the Canaanites.
 - a. In spite of the power of God.
