Our Shepherd-King (*Zechariah 9-10*)

- I. The protective judgement of the King. (*9:1-8*)
 - A. The siege of Alexander the Great.
 - 1. 336-332 B.C. Crosses into Turkey, defeats Darius at Issus.
 - 2. Marches southward into Damascus, Tyre, Sidon, etc.
 - 3. Spares Jerusalem.

- II. The peaceful entrance of the King. (*9:9,10*)
 - A. The prophecy fulfilled. (*9:9*)
 - 1. The Triumphal entry. (*Matthew 21:5*) (*John 12:15*)
 - B. The king described.
 - 1. Just and righteous is His rule.
 - 2. Salvation is His name (Jesus). (*Matthew 1:21*) (*Acts 4:12*)
 - 3. Humility is His demeanor. (*Isaiah 53*)
 - 4. Peace is His mission. (*Isaiah 9:6*) (*John 14:27*) (*Philippians 4:6-7*)
(*Revelation 20-22*)
 - C. The prophecy predicted. (*9:10*)
 - 1. His second advent. (*Revelation 19*)

- III. The powerful provision of the King. (*9:11-10:12*)
 - A. The shepherd saves His people. (*9:14-17*)
 - B. The shepherd provides for His people. (*10:1-2*)
 - C. The shepherd purifies His people. (*10:3-5*)
 - D. The shepherd gathers His people. (*10:6-12*)
