- I. God has ALWAYS had a people. (*Vs. 6*)
  - A. The Godhead from the beginning. (*Genesis 1:26*) ELOHIM
  - B. Abram (Abraham), the Father of a Nation. (*Genesis 12*) (*Romans 4*)
  - C. David, the King. (*I Samuel 16:11ff*)
  - D. Jeremiah, the Prophet. (*Jeremiah 1:5*)
  - E. You, the Believer.
    - 1. Through the foreknowledge of God. (*Romans 8*) (*I Peter 1:1,2*)
    - 2. By the quickening love of God. (*Ephesians 2*)
    - 3. By the electing grace of God. (*John 15:16*) (*I Peter 2:9,10*)
  
- II. Jesus has ALWAYS been our Savior. (*Vss. 7,8*)
  - A. Declared by Isaiah.
    - 1. The Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many. (*Isaiah 53:11b*)
  - B. Announced by Matthew.
    - 1. The record of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah... (*Matthew 1:1*)
    - 2. You shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins. (*Matthew 1:21*)
  - C. Proclaimed by John the Baptist.
    - 1. Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! (*John 1:29-34*)
  - D. Stated by Jesus Christ.
    - 1. As the Bread of Life. (*John 6:35-51*)
    - 2. As the only way to the Father. (*John 6:44,65*)
    - 3. As our Teacher. (*John 6:66-71*) (*John 15:1-27*)
  - E. Illustrated by the Apostles Paul and Peter.
    - 1. Our propitiation. (*Romans 3:25,26*)
    - 2. Our shepherd. (*I Peter 2:21-25*)
    - 3. Our redeemer. (to buy back)
      - a. He purchased the church. (*Acts 20:28*)
      - b. He bought us with a price. (*I Corinthians 6:20*)
      - c. He paid for us with His blood. (*Ephesians 1:7*)
      - d. He met the requirement as the spotless lamb of God. (*I Peter 1:17-21*)
      - e. He purchased individuals from every tribe and nation. (*Revelation 5:9,10*)
