God's Protective Power (*John 17:11-12*)

- I. God's protective power is the holy character of God.
 - A. In the name of God.
 - 1. Our helper in the midst of hostility. (*Psalm 54*)
 - 2. Our tower for the sake of safety. (*Proverbs 18:10*)
 - B. By the salvation of God.
 - 1. Greater is He who is in us. (*I John 4:4*)
 - 2. The hope of glory is in us. (*Colossians 1:27*)

- II. God's protective power is the holy person of God.
 - A. Jesus is the manifestation of God.
 - 1. In the flesh. (*John 1:14*)
 - 2. In His power.
 - a. Over nature. (*Luke 8:22-25*)
 - b. Over Satan. (*Luke 22:31-32*)
 - B. Jesus is the salvation of God. (*John 6:44, 65; 14:6*)
 - 1. For security. (*John 6:39; 10:26-30*)
 - 2. For separation.
 - a. From the sons of perdition. (*Psalm 41:9*)
 - b. From the chaff of the earth. (*Psalm 1*)
 - c. Between the sheep and the goats. (*Matthew 25*)
 - d. From the names missing in the book of life. (*Revelation 20:15*)
