It's Still All About Jesus! (Colossians 3:15-17)

- I. Let the PEACE of Christ rule in your hearts. (Vs. 15)
 - A. We are at peace with God. (Romans 5:1) (Ephesians 2:14)
 - B. We have the peace of God. (John 14:27) (Philippians 4:7)
 - 1. The umpire of our decisions is God's peace.
 - a. Does it unify us with the will of God? (I Corinthians 6:17-18)
 - b. Does it leave us with a sense of peace in our hearts? (Isaiah 26:3)
- II. Let the WORD of Christ dwell in you richly. (Vs. 16)
 - A. The revelation of Scripture. (2 Timothy 3:16-17) (Psalm 1, 19, 119)
 - B. The content of Scripture. (Logos=Jesus). (John 1:1-5, 14) (Revelation 1)
 - 1. Living within us, able to teach God's wisdom. (2 Timothy 2:15)
 - 2. Living within us, able to admonish one another. (2 Timothy 3:16)
 - 3. Living within us, able to sing praises to God.
 - a. The book of Psalms. (Old Testament)
 - b. Hymns. (New Testament). (Philippians 2:6-11) (Colossians 1:15-20)
 - c. Spiritual songs. (Revelation 5:9-10)
- III. Let the NAME of Christ direct everything you do. (Vs. 17)
 - A. The name that saves us. (Acts 4:12)
 - B. The name that guards us. (Romans 13:14)
 - C. The name that keeps us. (John 10:27-28)
 - D. The name that causes gratitude in us. (I Thessalonians 5:16-18)
