- I. The Probing Questions. (Vss. 19-24a)
 - A. WHY THE LAW?
 - 1. The fact of sin.
 - a. Defining transgressions. (Romans 3:23; 7:7)
 - 2. The reality of standards.
 - a. God's Word is the final standard.
 - B. WHAT IS A MEDIATOR?
 - 1. An angel with a message. (Acts 7:53) (Hebrews 2:2)
 - 2. Moses with commandments. (Exodus 19,20)
 - 3. Jesus with salvation. (I Timothy 2:5)
 - C. IS THE LAW CONTRARY TO GRACE?
 - 1. No, the Law is for discipline. (Hebrews 12:6)
 - 2. No, the Law is for conviction. (Acts 2)
 - 3. No, the Law is our tutor.
 - a. Paidogogos: tutor = child conductor. (I Corinthians 4:15)

 - b. Pedagogy: The method and practice of teaching, especially as an academic subject or theoretical concept.
