 - 1. Goliath. (I Samuel 17)

 - B. You reap what you sow.
 - 1. Corruption.
 - 2. Eternal life.
- III. A divine promise for continued service. (Vss. 9, 16)
 - A. Renewed strength. (Isaiah 40:29-31)
 - B. Perfect peace. (Isaiah 26:3) (Philippians 4) (I Corinthians 15:58)
- IV. A divine encouragement for ending well. (Vss. 10-18)
 - A. Continue in goodness. (Vs. 10) (Galatians 5:22)
 - B. Know your doctrine. (Vs. 12) (2 Timothy 3:16,17) (2 Timothy 2:15)
 - C. Practice discernment. (Vs. 13) (I John 4:1) (I Thessalonians 5:15-22)
 - D. Glory in the Cross as a new creation in Christ. (Vss. 14,15) (I Corinthians 2:1-5)
 - a. We are a new creation in Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:17)
 - b. We are His workmanship (poem). (Ephesians 2:10)
 - c. We are being renovated daily in Him! (Colossians 3:9-11)
