The Flesh vs. The Spirit (Galatians 5:16-26)

- I. The Challenge. (Vss. 16,18, 25-26)
 - A. Our daily walk.
 - 1. The description: Psalm 1:1-2
 - 2. The warning: Ephesians 5:15-21
- II. The Conflict. (Vs 17)
 - A. Our sin nature is always against our new nature.
 - 1. The description: Romans 7:14-24
 - 2. The answer: Romans 7:25-8:1-2
- III. The Characteristics. (Vss. 19-24)
 - A. The Flesh revealed. (I Corinthians 6:9-11)
 - 1. Sexual immorality: (porneia) (I Corinthians 6:19,20)
 - 2. Impurity: uncleanness.
 - 3. Sensuality: indecency, lack of respect, flaunting in public.
 - 4. Idolatry: worship of other gods.
 - 5. Sorcery: worship of evil. (pharmakeia) occult, Satan worship, drug addiction, magical spells (*Isaiah 47:9*) (*Nahum 3:4*) (*Revelation 9:21; 18:23, 22:15*)
 - 6. Interpersonal relationships: enmities (enemy) (Vs. 20-21a)
 - B. The Holy Spirit's Fruit.
 - 1. Love: Agape, (John 15) the cross of Christ.
 - 2. Joy: contentment not determined by circumstances.
 - 3. Peace: wholeness and well-being. (Philippians 4)
 - 4. Patience: long-suffering, a slow fuse.
 - 5. Kindness: constant readiness to help.
 - 6. Goodness: moral excellence. (2 Peter 1:5ff)
 - 7. Faithfulness: reliable, loyal, trustworthy.
 - 8. Gentleness: humble, (meek=power under control)
 - 9. Self-control: temperance or moderation
 - C. The Christian's Action. (Vs. 24) CRUCIFIXION! (Galatians 2:20)
