I AM He (Messiah) (John 4:7-26; 12:12-16)

- I. The Messiah who transcends social and religious taboos.
 - A. A Jewish male speaking to a Samaritan woman.
 - 1. Asked her for a drink.
 - 2. Turns the conversation toward the gift of God.
 - B. A stranger who promises eternal life.
 - 1. Living water.
 - 2. Cleansing water.
- II. The Messiah who exposes sin and presents the truth.
 - A. The exposure of sin.
 - 1. The present man is not her husband.
 - 2. The present subject leads to discomfort.
 - B. The declaration of truth.
 - 1. I am He; Believe Me.
 - 2. True worshippers worship in spirit and truth.
- III. The Messiah who is not limited by political expectations.
 - A. The King of Israel who conquers Rome.
 - 1. The significance of the palm branches.
 - B. The conqueror who rides a war horse.
 - 1. The significance of the donkey.
 - a. Power (Isaiah 31:1-3)
 - b. Prophecy. (Zechariah 9:9-11)
