Our Identity in Christ (Part 1)

ROMANS: Called of Jesus Christ, beloved of God in Rome, called as saints.

I CORINTHIANS: Church of God at Corinth, saints by calling. II CORINTHIANS: Church of God at Corinth, all the saints.

GALATIANS: Churches of Galatia. EPHESIANS: To the saints at Ephesus.

PHILIPPIANS: To all the saints. COLOSSIANS: To the saints.

I & II THESSALONIANS: To the church of the Thessalonians.

I TIMOTHY: My true child in the faith.

II TIMOTHY: My beloved son.

TITUS: My true child in a common faith. PHILEMON: to the church in your house.

HEBREWS: Chapter 3: Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling.

JAMES: To the twelve tribes scattered abroad.

I PETER: To those who reside as aliens, who are chosen.

II PETER: To those who have received a faith of the same kind as ours.

I JOHN: What we have seen we proclaim to you so that you may have fellowship with us.

II JOHN: the elder to the chosen lady and her children.

III JOHN: the elder to the beloved Gaius.

JUDE: To those who are the called.

REVELATION: The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His

bondservants.

- I. We are CALLED by God.
 - A. Called to salvation. (Romans 8:28-31)
 - B. Called as the church of Jesus Christ.
 - 1. Ekklesia: Called out assembly. (Hebrews 10:19-25)
- II. We are SAINTS of God.
 - A. Holy ones/sanctified. (I Corinthians 6:9-11)
 - B. People of faith and THE faith.
