

## Sermon Notes – June 26, 2022

## Temptation (James 1:13-16)

- I. God is Holy. (Vs. 13,16) (Levitcus 19:2; Habakkuk 1:13; Isaiah 6:3; I Peter 1:16)
  A. God is untemptable.
  - 1. There is no evil in His character: God is Light.
  - 2. There is no desire for evil in His nature: God is Love. (I Corinthians 13:6a)
  - 3. There is no leading to evil in His purposes: God tests us in allowing trials. (*James 1:2-12*) (*Romans 8:28*)
  - B. Christ is our example.
    - 1. Jesus was led by the Spirit to be tested. (peirazo) (Matthew 4:1) (Mark 1:12)
    - 2. Jesus passed His test by not yielding to temptation. (peirazo) (Hebrews 4:15)
- II. Christians are at War. (Vss. 14-15)
  - A. The battle is with the flesh.
    - 1. In my flesh there is no good thing. (Romans 7:18) (Matthew 26:41)
    - 2. My flesh sets itself against the Spirit. (Galatians 5)
  - B. The battle is with the process of sin.
    - 1. Desire conceives its offspring, which is sin.
      - a. The heart is deceitful. (Jeremiah 17:9)
      - b. The heart is the source of evil. (Matthew 15:18-20)
    - 2. The lust of the flesh lures into a trap. (Genesis 3) (I John 2:16)
    - 3. The lust of the flesh entices with bait.
    - 4. The completion of sin leads to death.
      - a. Physical death for the Christian. (I Corinthians 11:30) (I John 5:16)
      - b. Spiritual death for the unbeliever. (Romans 6:23)
