Life Is A Vapor (James 4:11-17)

- I. To set ourselves above the Law of God. (Vss. 11-12)
 - A. By slandering those who cannot defend themselves.
 - 1. Malicious gossip.
 - 2. Ignorance of facts. (James 2)
 - B. By placing ourselves above God as judges.
 - 1. Usurping His right to vengeance. (Romans 12:19)
 - 2. Usurping His right to pronounce a final verdict. (Revelation 20:11-15)
- II. To set ourselves above the Plans of God. (Vss. 13-14)
 - A. The events of life.
 - 1. To do everyday activities with no thought of God.
 - a. No prayer.
 - b. No Bible.
 - c. No Worship.
 - B. The timing of death.
 - 1. To make plans with no thought of eternity.
 - a. Boasting about tomorrow. (Proverbs 27:1)
 - b. Boasting about success. (Luke 12:16-21)
- III. To set ourselves above the Will of God. (Vss. 15-17)
 - A. We are to depend upon God for everything.
 - 1. Delight, commit, rest in the Lord. (Psalm 37)
 - 2. Pray without ceasing. (I Thessalonians 5:17)
 - B. We are to obey God in everything.
 - 1. Obedience is better than sacrifice. (1 Samuel 15:22)
 - 2. Obedience is the definition of faith. (Hebrews 11)
