Swear No More (James 5:12)

- I. The Importance of Speech.
 - A. An unbridled tongue is evidence of a worthless religion. (James 1:26)
 - B. Speak as one who is under the law of liberty. (James 2:12)
 - C. Controlling the tongue is hard; do it anyway! (James 3:2-11)
 - D. Do not slander another believer. (James 4:11)
 - E. Our speech is to be evidence of a living faith. (Matthew 12:34-37) (Luke 6:43-45)
- II. The Meaning of Swearing.
 - A. The making of OATHS.
 - 1. To make a vow.
 - a. I swear to tell the truth...Court.
 - b. With this ring I thee wed...Marriage.
 - c. I will remain faithful to the Word of God...Ordination.
- III. The Challenge for the Christian.
 - A. Don't make vows in haste.
 - 1. The soldier in the foxhole.
 - 2. King Herod.
 - B. Don't blaspheme God. (Matthew 5:33-37)
 - 1. The attempt to deceive others.
 - 2. Peter at the crucifixion.
 - C. Don't use too many words!
 - 1. A person of character only needs to say yes or no to be trusted.
 - 2. A person who uses too many words to convince brings suspicion.
