Give Thanks to the Lord! - Part 1 (*Psalm 118*)

INTRODUCTION

Psalms 113-118 are known as the Egyptian Hallel. (Moses)

Hallel= Praise Yahweh!

Sung in connection to the Passover.

Most likely sung by Jesus and the disciples: Matthew 26:30 and Mark 14:26.

 - A. His goodness in creating us. Psalm 100
 - B. His everlasting love for us. Psalm 103
 - C. His mighty deeds around us. Psalm 106
 - D. His redemption supplied to us. Psalm 107

 - II. Give thanks to God for His salvation. (*Vss. 25,26*)
 - A. Hosanna in the highest! (Save us)
 - 1. He came to save His people from their sins.
 - a. Matthew 1:21
 - 2. He gave His life as a ransom for many.
 - a. Matthew 20:28; Mark 10:45
 - 3. He shed His blood for the forgiveness of sins.
 - a. Ephesians 1:7
 - B. The rejected stone became the capstone. (*Vss. 22-24*)
 - 1. Salvation is of the Lord.
 - a. Jonah 2:9
 - 2. By His stripes we are healed.
 - a. Hebrews 9:22
 - 3. By His resurrection He became the chief cornerstone.
 - a. Acts 4:11,12
