## Poverty Giving (2 Corinthians 8:1-9)

- I. Motivated by GRACE. (Vs. 1)
  - A. The grace of God's salvation. (Ephesians 2:8-9)
  - B. The grace of God's blessings. (Ephesians 1) (James 1:17)
- II. Driven by our RELATIONSHIP with GOD. (Vs. 2)
  - A. The joy of the Lord overcomes the circumstances of life.
    - 1. The joy of the Lord is our strength. (Psalm 28)
    - 2. Count it all joy. (James 1)
  - B. The sincerity of our faith will result in a wealth of generosity.
    - 1. God so loved the world that He GAVE... (John 3:16)
- III. Performed through INDIVIDUAL choice. (Vs. 3) (I Corinthians 16:1-4) A. Giving is to be proportional.
  - B. Giving is to be sacrificial. (2 Corinthians 9:6)
  - C. Giving is to be voluntary.
- IV. Envisioned as a PRIVILEGE. (Vss. 4-8)
  - A. The privilege of participation.
  - B. The privilege of support.
  - C. The privilege of service.
    - 1. Living sacrifice. (Romans 12)
    - 2. Expressing faith, hope and love. (I Corinthians 13)
- V. Results in INCARNATIONAL living. (Vs. 9)
  - A. The attitude of Christ displayed. (Philippians 2:5-11)
  - B. The true riches of the spiritual life experienced.
    - 1. Joint heirs of Christ. (Romans 8:17)
    - 2. The fruit of the Spirit. (Galatians 5:22ff)
    - 3. Every spiritual blessing possessed. (Ephesians 1)
