

Sermon Notes – August 27, 2023

Useless (2 Peter 1:8-11)

- I. Uselessness results in due diligence being ignored. (5) (Vss. 8,9)
 - A. Evidence of conversion fades.
 - B. The grace of God means little.
 - 1. His benefits are forgotten. (Psalm 103:1-5)
 - 2. Forgiveness of sins means little. (Ephesians 1) (Vs. 9)
- II. Unfruitfulness results in the lack of cultivation of works. (Vs. 10)
 - A. God's grace should lead to intense effort. (Psalm 1)
 - 1. Salvation with works; not by works. (James)
 - 2. Growth from milk to meat. (Hebrews 5:7-14)
 - B. The practice of holiness guards against apostasy. (Vs. 10)
 - 1. "Objective obedience is the foundation for subjective assurance."
 - 2. Elective calling is concretely shown through continuous abiding.
 - a. Abiding in Christ. (John 15)
 - b. The Parable of the Sower. (Luke 8:11-15)
 - C. The righteousness of Christ is our confidence for entrance into Heaven.
 - 1. Confession of Christ, forsaking sin. (Romans 6, 10:9,10)
 - 2. Dependence upon Christ, forsaking pride. (Jude 12-16)
