God's Glorious Grace (2 Peter 1:1-4)

- I. The grace of His precious FAITH. (Vs. 1)
 - A. The authority of an Apostle; the mindset of a servant.
 - 1. One who is called of God.
 - 2. One who is a bond servant. (Romans 1:1)
 - B. The gift of faith to believe; the ability of faith to mature.
 - 1. Salvation is of the Lord.
 - a. Faith is a gift. (Philippians 1:29) (Acts 16:14)
 - b. Sonship is a privilege. (John 1:12,13)
 - 2. The righteousness of Christ is imparted to the believer.
 - a. Our testimony. (Galatians 2:20)
 - b. Our realization. (Romans 3:21,22)
- II. The grace of His powerful KNOWLEDGE. (Vs. 2,3a)
 - A. Grace and peace are multiplied through a deeper knowledge of God.
 - 1. Isaiah 26:3
 - 2. Philippians 4
 - B. Maturity is accomplished through a greater knowledge of the Word.
 - 1. The growth of Jesus. (Luke 2:52)
 - 2. The maturity of the believer. (2 Timothy 2:15; 3:16,17)
- III. The grace of His DIVINE NATURE. (Vss. 3,4)
 - A. All believers possess all things for life.
 - 1. Eternal life. (Ephesians 1)
 - 2. A godly life. (2 Peter 3:10-14)
 - B. All believers possess all of God's promises for eternity.
 - 1. The promise of His coming transforms us today.
 - 2. The promise of moral perfection describes our eternal state.
