God Knows How to Rescue You (2 Peter 2:4-11)

- I. God knows the worthy punishment of the wicked. (Vss. 4-6)
 - A. Rebellious angels. (Genesis 6:1-4)
 - 1. Sent to Tartarus: the deepest abyss; blackest darkness (Vs. 17)
 - 2. Reserved for judgment. (Revelation 19:20-21; 20:11-15)
 - B. Rejecting ancients. (Genesis 6:5-8:18)
 - 1. Rejected righteousness.
 - 2. Died in the flood.
 - C. Renegade sodomites. (Genesis 18:20-19:29)
 - 1. Went after strange flesh. (Jude 5-8)
 - a. Degrading passions. (Romans 1:26)
 - b. Abandoned the natural function. (Romans 1:27)
 - 2. Reduced to ashes.
- II. God knows how to rescue the righteous. (Vss. 5-9)
 - A. Noah, a preacher of righteousness.
 - 1. Lived among unbelievers.
 - 2. Proclaimed the truth to unbelievers.
 - B. Lot, a man of righteousness.
 - 1. Lived among the wicked.
 - 2. Oppressed and tortured by the wicked.
 - C. Christians, people of righteousness.
 - 1. The way of escape.
 - a. Through our faithful God. (I Corinthians 10:13)
 - 2. The rescue from wrath.
 - a. Through our resurrected Savior. (I Thessalonians 1:10; 4:13-18; 5:9) (Romans 5:8-11)
