

Sermon Notes – November 12, 2023

The Day of the Lord (*2 Peter 3:10-13*)

- I. The day of the Lord is a cataclysmic time of judgement.
 - A. Prophesied by Joel. (*Joel 2:1-2*)
 - B. Preached by Peter and Paul. (*Acts 2:14-21; Joel 2:28-32*) (*2 Thessalonians 2*)

- II. The day of the Lord will come unexpectedly.
 - A. As a thief in the night.
 - 1. Described by Jesus. (*Matthew 24:43; Luke 12:39; Revelation 3:3; 16:15*)
 - 2. Stated by Paul. (*1 Thessalonians 5:2-3*)
 - B. As in the days of Noah.
 - 1. Evil will be the norm. (*Genesis 6:5*)
 - 2. Life with no consideration of God will be the norm. (*Matthew 24:37-39*)

- III. The day of the Lord is the positive motivation for God's people.
 - A. Looking for a new creation.
 - 1. Prophesied by Isaiah. (*Isaiah 65:17-66; 22*)
 - 2. Declared in Revelation. (*Revelation 21:1-5*)
 - B. Living like a new creation.
 - 1. Someone who is saved. (*2 Corinthians 5:17*)
 - 2. Someone who is serious. (*1 John 3:1-3*)
 - a. Eager expectation.
 - b. Praying for the kingdom to come.
 - 3. Someone who is sanctified. (*1 Corinthians 6:9-11*) (*Revelation 21:25-27*)
