Reconciled (Philemon 17-25)

RECONCILED: to set to one's account. To be right with God.

- I. Initiated by God's Love.
 - A. God SO loved the world. (John 3:16,17)
 - B. God enacted His love for the world. (2 Corinthians 5:17-21) (I John 4:7-10.19)
- II. Accomplished through Christs' death.
 - A. We are healed through His crucifixion. (Isaiah 53:4-5)
 - B. We are forgiven through His propitiation. (Romans 3:25) (I John 2:2)
- III. Observed through the Holy Spirit's ministry.
 - A. The power of the Holy Spirit to change lives. (Galatians 2:20)
 - B. The assurance of the Holy Spirit to give hope. (Colossians 1:27) (Romans 8:16-17)
