

Sermon Notes – November 2, 2025

The Confession of our Hope (Hebrews 10:19-25)

In summarizing the great lessons of the fact that Jesus is our High Priest, the author now gives us three exhortations in living out these great lessons. Knowing is one thing; doing is another. Here are three examples of what living out confessional truth looks like.

- I. Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart. (Vs. 22)
 - A. A sincere heart is a true heart. (John 4:24)
 - B. A sincere heart is a loyal heart. (John 15:10)
 - C. A sincere heart is a pure heart. (Psalm 24) (Matthew 5:8) (Hebrews 12:14)
- II. Let us hold fast our confession of hope. (Vs. 23)
 - A. Having full assurance in Christ until the end. (Hebrews 6:11)
 - B. Having the ability to give an answer for our faith. (I Peter 3:14,15)
 - C. Having the confidence that God keeps His promises. (Hebrews 11:11)
- III. Let us consider how to provoke each other. (Vs. 24,25)
 - A. To love God and each other. (Matthew 22:37-40)
 - B. To do good works. (Titus 3:8) (James)
 - C. To worship God corporately. (Acts 2:42)
