

Sermon Notes – November 2, 2025

The Confession of our Hope (*Hebrews 10:19-25*)

In summarizing the great lessons of the fact that Jesus is our High Priest, the author now gives us three exhortations in living out these great lessons. Knowing is one thing; doing is another. Here are three examples of what living out confessional truth looks like.

- I. Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart. (*Vs. 22*)
 - A. A sincere heart is a true heart. (*John 4:24*)
 - B. A sincere heart is a loyal heart. (*John 15:10*)
 - C. A sincere heart is a pure heart. (*Psalms 24*) (*Matthew 5:8*) (*Hebrews 12:14*)

- II. Let us hold fast our confession of hope. (*Vs. 23*)
 - A. Having full assurance in Christ until the end. (*Hebrews 6:11*)
 - B. Having the ability to give an answer for our faith. (*I Peter 3:14,15*)
 - C. Having the confidence that God keeps His promises. (*Hebrews 11:11*)

- III. Let us consider how to provoke each other. (*Vs. 24,25*)
 - A. To love God and each other. (*Matthew 22:37-40*)
 - B. To do good works. (*Titus 3:8*) (*James*)
 - C. To worship God corporately. (*Acts 2:42*)
