

Sermon Notes – August 2, 2026

Holy, Holy, Holy! (*Psalm 99*)

- I. The magnitude of God's holiness. (*Vss. 1-3*)
 - A. The Bible calls God holy more than anything else.
 - B. The emphasis is made clear in its repetition. (*Isaiah 6:3*) (*Revelation 4:8*)
 - C. The exclusivity of this attribute is obvious. (*Exodus 15:11*) (*Psalm 30:4*) (*Revelation 15:4*)

- II. The righteousness of God's holiness. (*Vss. 4-5*)
 - A. He is a lover of justice.
 - B. He proves His love for His own. (*Jacob: Romans 9:13*)
 - C. He has provided mercy.
 - 1. His footstool, the ark of the covenant.
 - 2. The mercy seat, sprinkled with blood.
 - 3. His death, our only way of salvation.

- III. The results of God's holiness. (*Vss. 6-9*)
 - A. Through His perfect sacrifice, we have access to God.
 - B. Through His perfect life, we have answered prayer.
 - C. Through His perfect shed blood, we have forgiveness of sins.

 - 3. Hebrews 9:11-15
